3. Purposes and legal basis of the processing

Your personal data will be collected and processed for the purpose of documenting and administering your registration for this event. We retain your name, telephone number, job title within the company, email address, as well as the name of the company. Such processing is carried out in accordance with Art. 6(1)(b) GDPR.

Please note that the event will be photographed and/or filmed. The photos and videos will be used to document the event and for our public relations work (e.g. print, online, social media) and serve the informational interests of our members and participants. The processing is based on our legitimate interest pursuant to Art. 6(1)(f) GDPR. Any further processing beyond the purpose of presenting and documenting the event will only take place based on your consent. If you do not wish to be photographed, please avoid areas where photos and videos are being taken or inform the photographer directly so your request can be respected.

4. Recipients or categories of recipients of personal data

In individual cases, specific categories of personal data (i.e. surname, first name, and company affiliation) may be disclosed to selected third parties, such as participants, speakers, ministries, or embassies, where necessary for the proper organization and conduct of the event. Such disclosure is carried out pursuant to Art. 6(1)(f) GDPR and serves to safeguard legitimate interests.

5. Transfer of personal data to a third country

6. Duration of storage of personal data

Your data will be stored only for the duration of the event and will be deleted afterwards, unless legal retention obligations require continued storage. This Storage period does not apply to photo and video recordings.

7. Rights of data subjects

According to the basic EU data protection regulation, you have the following rights:

- If your personal data is processed, you have the right to obtain information about the data stored about your person (Art. 15 GDPR).
- Should incorrect personal data be processed, you have the right to correction (Art. 16 GDPR).
- If the legal requirements are met, you can demand that the processing be deleted or restricted and lodge an objection against the processing (Art. 17, 18 and 21 GDPR). In the event of an objection, we can no longer contact you as a participant of the event, and we would delete you from the mailing list.
- Since data processing is based on a contract and is carried out using automated procedures, you may have a right to data portability (Art. 20 GDPR).
